Youth Awards Program Details – 2009

Skagit Farmers Supply (SFS) wants to reward you for your accomplishments in 4-H, Pony Club and FFA. We are recognizing you and your club/chapter for your achievements.

The SFS Youth Awards Program recognizes your accomplishments in many ways:

- Youth participants will earn a 10% rebate on all eligible project purchases by using their SFS Youth Awards Program account. **This is the only proof of purchase used to calculate your yearend rebate and the Equine/Market Animal feed awards eligibility.**
- Your club/chapter will earn a 5% rebate for each club member's purchases on account.
- No rebates will be issued for less than \$10.00
- Rebates accrue October thru September. Youth must sign up each year beginning in October.
- Youth enrolled in the SFS Equine and Market Animal Awards programs have the opportunity to win additional awards.
- *A SFS Youth Awards Program Account Number* (cash only account) will be issued to each participant and must be used when purchasing approved project items. Charge accounts are available for Youth with Parents signature, please contact our Credit Department at 888-757-6053 for details.

Qualification Rules

- ❖ All feeds carried by SFS Country Stores, including nutritional supplements and commodity feeds are considered qualifying feeds and must be purchased from SFS.
- ❖ Feed / Supplement purchase expectations per project animal are the following: Beef – 1500 lbs, Swine – 400 lbs, Lamb / Meat Goat – 150 lbs and Horse 400 lbs (feed equivalent with appropriate supplement).
- ❖ Youth may receive no more than two (2) Grand Champion or Reserve Champion awards per year.
- ❖ Only one Grand Champion or Reserve Champion award per year per animal.
- ❖ Register each project or animal; specify show/sale: PSJLA, Skagit Co. Fair, Island Co. Fair, San Juan Co. Fair.
- ❖ Equine be sure to specify Class (Performance, Gaming, etc.) and Age Division.

Equine Awards

- ❖ Awarded to qualified participants exhibiting a Horse Project at a County Fair in Showmanship Class.
- ❖ Grand Champion Fitting and Showing (all age divisions) - \$50 Award
- ❖ Reserve Grand Champion Fitting and Showing (all age divisions) - \$35 Award
- ❖ Riding vest for Grand Champion winners (1 per participant for the life of the program)
- ❖ Blue Ribbon participants earn \$25, Red Ribbon participants earn \$15 if not receiving Grand or Reserve Champion.

Market Animal Awards

- ❖ Awards to qualified participants exhibiting a Market Animal at a terminal Show and Sale.
- ❖ Overall Grand Champion Market Class - \$200 Beef / \$150 Swine / \$100 Lamb or Meat Goat
- ❖ Overall Reserve Grand Champion Market Class - \$100 Beef / \$75 Swine / \$50 Lamb or Meat Goat
- ❖ Jacket for Overall Grand Champion winners (1 per participant for the life of the program)
- ❖ Blue Ribbon participants earn \$25, Red Ribbon participants earn \$15 if not receiving Grand or Reserve Champion.
